Applicants should:

1. Hold of PhD degree in any discipline of pure and applied Sciences and Engineering OR M.S./M.D. in Medical sciences and be less than 40 years of age as on 31st December 2019 (One year age relaxation for women candidates who give adequate justification).
2. Be a citizen of India, working in an academic/research position in India.
3. Provide Two Letters of support to qualify a valid application. The letters can be provided by
 - (i) Fellows of any Indian Academy of Science/ Engineering
 - (ii) Directors/ Heads of institutes (present employer)
 - (iii) Heads/ Chairpersons of Departments in Universities (present employer)

- Each INYAS member is expected to attend the Annual General Meeting of INYAS each year and is also expected to actively contribute to one or more of the INYAS activities and also plan new activities for the promotion of Science and INYAS as well.
